Effective April 22, 2010, the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) "Lead: Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule" (RRP) requires any HVAC/R Contractor to have a Lead Renovator's Certification who works on a house or a child occupied facility built before 1978 and disturbs 6 sq. ft. or more of lead-based painted surface.

View the EPA's website (www.epa.gov/lead/pubs/sbcomplianceguide.pdf) and read the "Small Entity Compliance Guide to Renovate Right". This gives you an overview of the rule and how it applies to you as an HVAC/R contractor.
